## What Every Citizen Needs to Know

### ✓ It's Constitutional!

- ✓ The Census Occurs Every 10 Years.
- ✓ Every Citizen Counts and Is Important.
- ✓ It is Every Citizen's Civic Duty.

### ✓ It's About Fair Representation!

- ✓ Determines Reapportionment of the US House of Representatives.  
(Tennessee expects to gain 1 seat)
- ✓ Determines State Redistricting and Representation in Nashville.

### ✓ Census Data Drives Local Benefits!

- ✓ Local Governments use it for **Public Safety & Emergency Preparedness.**
- ✓ Real Estate Developers use it to **Build New Homes and Revitalize Communities.**
- ✓ Businesses use it to **Decide Where to Build New Factories, Offices, Stores and Restaurants – Creating Job Opportunities.**

### ✓ Census Data Is Protected & Secure!

- ✓ Stored Separately, Protected Servers.
- ✓ By Law Cannot Be Used Against You or Shared with Other Agencies.

### ✓ Determines Allocation of Federal Funds!

- ✓ \$675 Billion Annually.
- ✓ \$1,500 per Person for State Programs or almost \$18 Billion for Tennessee.
- ✓ \$147 per Person for Local Programs or over **\$2 Million for Cannon County per year / \$20 Million over 10 years.**

3. Is this house, apartment, or mobile home—Owned by you or someone in this household with a mortgage or loan? Include home equity loans. a. Owned by you or someone in the household free and clear (without a mortgage or loan)? b. Rented? c. Occupied without payment of rent?
4. What is your telephone number?
5. What is Person 1's name?
6. What is Person 1's sex?
7. What is Person 1's age and what is Person 1's date of birth?
8. Is Person 1 of Hispanic, Latino, or Spanish origin?
9. What is Person 1's race?

## **Questions for Each Additional Person Residing in the Residence Identified Above:**

10. What is Person #'s Name?
11. Does Person # usually live or stay somewhere else? [a) No; b) Yes, for college; c) Yes, for a military assignment; d) Yes, for a job or business; e) Yes, in a nursing home; f) Yes, with a parent or other relative; g) Yes, at a seasonal or second residence; h) Yes, in a jail or prison; i) Yes, for another reason.]
